## REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (CONSULTANCY SERVICES-FIRM SELECTION)

- 1. The Government of Kenya (GOK) has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Second Kenya Informal Settlements Improvement Project (KISIP2) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.
- 2. The consulting services (the Services) include: (a) Conduct independent verification of Components 1.2-Infrastructure upgrading which shall be implemented at the selected counties and Component 2 which includes the LICW which shall be implemented by the national government with input from select counties as well (b) Include an integrated package of investments to upgrade settlements in line with the eligibility criteria (c) Ensure that the construction works and other labour-related activities continue to create jobs in the informal settlements through the LICW initiative. (d) Following up and resolving challenges related to budget and work planning, disbursement, accounting, internal control, financial reporting and audit issues of the project. The assignment is expected to take an overall period of Sixty (60) months.

The Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works ,State Department of Housing and Urban Development (the Client) through its Project Implementation Team, now invites eligible consulting firm ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting requirements for the Firm's experience are: (a) Core business as a consulting firm with at least Eight (8) years relevant experience in the field of public financial management, audit and assurance, capacity building, infrastructure project financing, project management, monitoring and evaluation (b) Demonstration of having been involved in successful execution, completed and/or ongoing, of at least two (2) projects of similar nature both in scope and complexity in similar operating environment in the last ten (5) years with preferably one (1) project, completed or ongoing, in county governments in the last five (5) years. Details

of the assignment-Name and address of the client, scope, value, and period shall be provided (c) Technical capability to undertake the assignment which should be supported by detailed company profiles; and (d) Availability of knowledge and appropriate skills among key consultant staff. **Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.**
